


Baby's 8ply Medium Buttoning Cardigan



As with the 4ply cardigan you can also opt to use a variegated yarn and use a plain contrast for the bands.

Yarn Requirements – 8 ply – 50g balls

Quantity	3	5	5	6	8	8

Quantities are approximate as they vary between knitters and yarns used.

Tension

22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm, (4in) over stocking stitch on 4mm needles or the size required to give correct tension. Check your tension – if less stitches use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle.

You will need:

1 pair each 4mm (No.8) and 3.25mm (No. 10) knitting needles or sizes needed to give correct tension, a stitch holder and 4(4,4,5,5,5,) buttons.

Abbreviations

Back

Using 3.25mm needles and thumb method cast on 58 [66,70,78,86,90] sts.

1st Row. K2 *p2, k2, rep from * to end.

2nd Row. P2, *k2, p2, rep from * to end. These 2 rows will now be referred to as **2x2 rib**

Work 5 rows more in 2x2 rib.

8th Row. P3 [5,2,5,3,5], p2tog, (p5 [4,5,4,4,5], p2tog) 7 [9,9,11,13,11] times, p4 [5,3,5,3,6] 50 [56,60,66,72,78] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and working in st-st cont until back measures 14 [17,20,25,28,33]cm, (5½ [6½, 8,9¾,11,13] in), ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Work 4 [5,6,6,7,8] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 42 [46,48,54,58,62] sts. Cont without shaping until armholes measure 10 [11,12,13,14, 15cm, $(4 [4\frac{1}{4}, 4\frac{3}{4}, 5\frac{1}{4}, 5\frac{1}{2}, 6] \text{ in})$ ending with a ws row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 6 [6,6,8,8,9] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 30 [34,36,38,42,44] sts. Cast off 6 [7,7,8,8,9] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 18 [20,22,22,26,26] sts.** Cast off rem 18 [20,22,22,26,26] sts.

Left Front

Using $3\frac{1}{4}$ mm needles and thumb method cast on 27 [31,35,35,39,43] sts.

1st Row. K2, *p2, k2, rep from * to last st, p1.

2nd Row. K1, p2, *k2, p2, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows set rib. Work 5 rows more in rib.

8th Row. P2 [3,2,2,3,3], p2tog, (p5 [4,3,8,6,5],p2tog) 3[4,6,3,4,5] times, p2 [2,1,1,2,3]. 23 [26,28,31,34,37] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and working in st-st cont until left front measures 14 [17,20,25,28,33]cm, (5½ [6½, 8, 9¾,11,13]in), ending with a ws row.**

Shape Armhole and Neck

1st Row. K2tog (armhole edge), knit to last 2 sts, k2tog (neck edge). 21 [24,26,29,32,35] sts.

2nd Row. Purl to last 2 sts, p2tog. 20 [23,25,28,31,34] sts.

1st and 2nd rows set armhole and neck shapings.

Work 2[3,4,4,5,6] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row **AT SAME**

TIME dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 0

[2nd,2nd,2nd,2nd] row.

17 [18,19,22,23,25] sts.

Work 19[20,21,23,26,27] rows

dec 1 st at neck edge only in 3rd [4th,1st,3rd 2nd 3rd] and every foll 4th row.

12 [13,13,16,16,18] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures 10 [11,12,13,14,15] cm, (4 $[4\frac{1}{4},4\frac{3}{4},5\frac{1}{4},5\frac{1}{2},6]$ in), ending with a ws row.

Shape Shoulder

Next Row. Cast off 6[6,6,8,8,9] sts, knit to end. 6 [7,7,8.8,9] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Cast off rem 6 [7,7,8,8,9] sts.

Right Front

Using 31/4 mm knitting needles and thumb methodcast on 27 [31,35,35,39,43] sts.

1st Row. P1, *k2, p2 rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

2nd Row. P2, *k2, p2, rep from * to last st, k1.

These 2 rows set rib. Work 5 more rows in rib.

8th Row. P2 [2,1,1,2,3],p2tog, (p5 [4,3,8,6,5], p2tog) 3[4,6,3,4,5] times, p2 [3,2,2,3,3]. 23 [26,28,31,34,37] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and working in st-stcont until right front measures 14 [17,20,25,28,33] cm, (5½ [6½, 8, 9¾,11,13] in), ending with a ws row.**

Shape Neck and Armhole

1st Row. K2tog (neck edge), knit to last 2 sts, k2tog (armhole edge). 21 [24,26,29,32,35] sts.

2nd Row. P2tog, purl to end. 20 [23,25,28,31,34] sts.

1st and 2nd rows set neck and armhole shapings.

Work 2 [3,4,4,5,6] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll 0 [2nd,2nd,2nd,2nd,2nd] row **AT SAME**

TIME dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row. 17 [18,19,22,23,25] sts.

Work 19 [20,21,23,26,27] rows dec 1 st at neck edge only in 3rd

[4th.1st,3rd,2nd,3rd] and every foll 4th

row. 12 [13m,13,16,16,18] sts.
Cont without shaping until armhole measures 10[11,12,13,14,15] cm, (4 [4½,4¾,5¼,5½,6] in) ending with a rs row.

Shape Shoulder

Next Row. Cast off 6[6,6,8,8,9] sts, purl to end 6 [7,7,8,8,9] sts **Next Row.** Knit. Cast off rem 6 [7,7,8,8,9] sts.

Sleeves (Both alike)

Using 31/4mm needles and thumb method cast on 42 [42, 46,46,54,54] sts, work 7 rows in 2x2 rib.

8th Row. P5 [5,1,2,1,5], (p2tog, p3) 0 [0,0,2,0] times, p2tog, (p4 [4,4,6,4,4], p2tog) 5 [5,7,5,5,7] times, (p3, p2tog) 0 [0,0,0,2,0] times, p5 [5,1,2,1,5]. 36 [36,38,40,44,46] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and working in st-st proceed as follows: inc 1 st at each end of 15th [7th,9th,9th,9th) and every foll 14th [8th,8th,8th,8th,8th] row to 40 [44,48,50,50,50] sts.

For 4th, 5th and 6th sizes only

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 10th row to [52,58,62] sts.

For all 6 sizes

Cont without shaping until sleeve measures 15 [17,20,24,29,33] cm, (6 [6½,8,9½,11½,13] in), or length required, ending with a ws row.

Shape Sleeve Top

Work 4 [5,6,6,7,8] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row. 32 [34,36,40,44,46] sts.

Work 0 [1,0,0,1,0] rows more without shaping.

Cast off 3 [5,4,4,4,5] sts at beg of next 4 [2,4,4,2,2] rows.

20 [24,20,24,36,36] sts.

Cast off 4 [5,4,5,5,5] sts at beg of next 4 [4,4,4,6,6] rows.

4 [4,4,4,6,6] sts.

Cast off rem 4 [4,4,4,6,6] sts.

Left Front Border

Join shoulder seams. With rs facing, starting at centre back of neck, using 3½ mm needles pick up and knit 9 [10,11, 11, 13,13] sts from back of neck, 30 [33,34,37,39,42] sts evenly along shaped edge, 32 [40,46,59,67,80] sts evenly along straight edge and 7 sts evenly along rib. 78 [90,98,114,126,142] sts.

Starting with 2nd row of 2x2 rib work 2 rows

Next Row. Rib 3 [2,2,3,3,4], cast off 1 st, (rib 9,12,14,13,15,18], cast off 1 st) 3 [3,3,4,4,4] times, rib to end.

Next Row. Rib to last 33 [41,47,59,67,80] sts. Cast on 1 st, (rib 10 [13,15,14,16,19], cast on1 st) 3 [3,3,4,4,4] times, rib 3 [2,2,3,3,4].

Work 3 rows more in rib. Cast off in rib.

Right Front Border

With rs facing, using 3½ mm needles pick up and knit 7 sts evenly along rib 32 [40,46,59, 67,80] sts evenly along straight edge, 30 [33,34,37,39,42] sts evenly along shaped edge and 9 [10,11,11,13,13] sts from back of neck to centre. 78 [90,98,114,126,142] sts. Starting with 2nd row of 2x2 rib work 7 rows.

Cast off in rib. To Make Up

Fold sleeves in half lengthways then, placing folds to shoulder seams, sew sleeves in position. Join side and sleeve seams. Join seam at back of neck. Sew on buttons.
